SECTION ONE

Table 1.1 contains information on the distribution of personnel in Nigeria Police Force which has senior, intermediate and junior levels spread across the Local Government Areas (LGA) in Ekiti. Available information from the records presents a total of 3,420 personnel which comprises of 391(11%) in senior cadre, 888(26%) intermediate and 2241 (66%) in junior category. Statistical analysis reveals that highest proportion of staff are in junior category while gender distribution of the workforce shows that just 290 officers (27.5%) were women and the rest men.

Table 1.2 contains a total of 2425 cases which includes house breaking, murder, rape, stealing and kidnapping among others reported to Nigeria Police Force in Ekiti in 2020. Offence relating to theft and stealing took the highest proportion of 48%, 5 (4.2%) cases were related to rape /defilement, 6 (0.3%) contradicts human trafficking law, 41 (1.8%) people were alleged for attempt to commit murder and 29(1.3%) had unlawful possessions.

Table 1.3 gives a comprehensive insight into the various noticeable crimes in the state. The issue of insecurity like stealing, fraud, murder, robbery, rape and defilement has continued to raise concern both at national and sub national levels. Prevalence of crime like theft/ stealing,cheating, fraud, murder, robbery, rape / defilement in Ekiti are as follows:48%, 15.6%, 4.9%, 24.2%, 1.7% and 2.5% respectively.

Table 1.5 presents information on number of NSCDC stations that was available in Ekiti State in 2021. From the record, there were 55 stations spread across 16 Local Government Areas,LGAs like Ikole and Ido/Osi have highest number of 6(11.5%)stations each, Oye and Irepodun/Ifelodun LGAs also have 5 (9.2%) stations each.

Table 1.6 explained that the Senatorial distribution of NSCDC Stations reveals that NSCDC stations were more concentrated in the Northern part of the state i.e. 21(40.4%) out of the total 55 stations and with just 13(25%) of it in the Southern part. see below for further details.

Table 1.8 presents numerous arrest made by NSCDC on various offences committed in the year. The record reveals the prevalence of criminal activities which consequently threatens the security and peace of lives and properties in the state with a total of 1065 arrest made in the year. The offence committed in the state ranges from stealing, theft, cheating, land matters, pregnancy denial and child abuse among others. From the table, alleged case of land matters seems to be most prevalent with the involvement of 753 Male (70.7%) and 312 Female (29.30%) which gulped 108 of the total Offences relating to Breach of contract agreement, Robbery and threat to life were also noted for concern as their percentages were 10.1, 0.7 and 2.2 respectively.

Reported cases settled or transferred to court were contained in Table 1.8 for years 2020 were 995 cases were settled and 74 transferred for further action.

Table 1.9 shows the distribution Analysis of staff of federal Road Safety Commission by Gender and Cadre is given for year 2020. The staff is divided by rank into officers and marshals group as well as by Cadre into senior, intermediate and Junior level. There were a total of 91 psersonnel in officers group comprising of 77male (85%) and 14 female (15%).

Out of the 317 total staff of FRSC in 2020 226 (71.3%) falls into the Marshal Category and 44 (14%) of them being female.

Table 1.11 a clear picture of analysis from the table reveals that as high as 214 which accounted for 67.5% of the human resources at the commission

belong to the Junior Cadre while 16 which amount to 5% of the staff belongs to the Senior Cadre.

Ekiti state had Seven (7) FRSC bases in year 2020 with Ado and Ido/Osi having Two (2) offices each. While Efon Alaye, Ekiti East and oye having 1 office each

The monthly record of traffic offenders caught by FRSC in 2020 was given in table 1.11. A total of 7672 people were trapped for committing various offences ranging from route violation, use of phone while driving, driving with worn out spare tyre, obstructing marshal on duty and failure to fix speed limiting among others. In the year 2020, a total of 1144 motor drivers were caught out of which there were no women arrested for the offence of driving without seat belt.

Specially, for the offence relating to use of phone while driving, a total of 37 drivers were caught while 1176 people were nabbed for driving with worn-out tyre, related kind of offence as high as 475 road users were arrested for the offence of failure to fix speed limiting device.

Information contained in table 1.13 focuses on the record of EKSTMA Stations in Ekiti for the year ended 2020. The only (1) office made available for the operation of the agency is located in Ado-Ekiti.

The focus of table 1.13 deals with the different categories to which the staffs of EKSTMA were divided into in 2020. Record shows that personnel (men) in the junior cadre accounted for high proportion of 76(84.4%) while men in the senior cadre gulped 5(5.6%) of the whole staff being 86.

The monthly record of traffic offenders arrested by EKSTMA in 2020 was the focus of Table 1.15. Available record shows that 86 drivers violated the traffic light, 12 drivers were arrested for making calls while driving and above 145 drivers were caught for obstruction. Meanwhile, there were no offenders

caught for offences like non-use of seat belt, and picking passengers on highways.

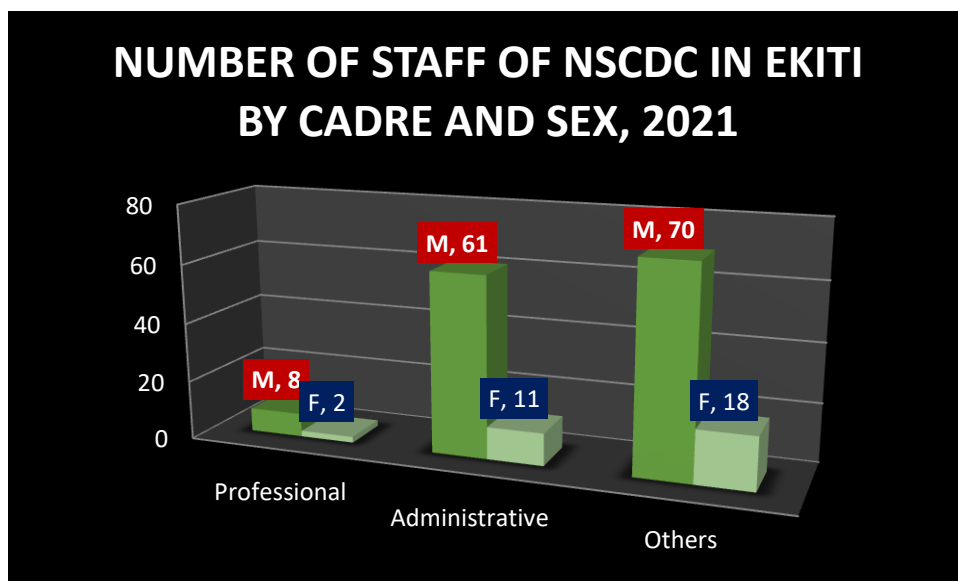

SECTION TWO

Section two analyses various activities of social welfare department of Ekiti State. The department saddle with responsibilities to monitor and evaluates family cases reported to the five (5) Zonal offices that super vices the activities within the State. 60 family cases were reported for 2020, of which 44 family cases of 73% were reconciled and 16 family cases were pending of which is 27% .Ministry of women Affairs, Social Welfare and Gender empowerment.

The record of beneficiaries of reformed programs coordinated by ministry of Women and Affairs, Social welfare and gender empowerment was the focus of table 2.2. There were various services being superintendent over by the ministry which includes giving of allowances to some children for their maintenance s, inmates on rehabilitation as well as making provisions for children in orphanage home. A total of 129 persons benefitted comprising of 73 females or 57% and 56 males 43.3%. 20 children were adopted which accounts for 16% of the total while the record shows that 31 children were in the motherless home, the percent which stood at 24%.There were no record for family dispute for the year. Fig 11 gives further details

Various offences committed by juvenile in Ekiti was presented in table 2.3. Record shows that 7 young ones were reported to be out of parental control.

SECTION THREE

Table 3.1 explains the capacity and actual number of inmates accommodated in Federal correctional services center in Ado-Ekiti as at 2020. The facility meant to accommodate 324 inmates was overloaded with 161 inmates bringing the percentage of congestion to 20%. Further pictorial information was presented in fig 12.

The distribution of Staff of Federal correctional services located in Ado-Ekiti into different cadre of professional, Administrative or other was contained in table 3.2 record in 2020. There were just 6 staff or 4% in the professional category, 149 (98%) in Administrative and as high as 5 (43%) staff belonging to other cadre. Only 122 staff (80%) was females and 30 staff or 20% were male, see fig 1.3 for details.

The record of available facilities in Federal correctional services in Ado-Ekiti ranging from recreational, religions and health facility were contained in table 3.3. in all, 73 facilities were available. Drum, megaphone, well, volleyball, water system, consulting room and beds were available.

The number of persons remanded who were awaiting trial was 109as given by table 3.4 of the record from Ado-Ekiti Federal correctional services in 2020. The record which were compile on monthly basis shows that on the average more than 38men were being remanded monthly while the figure for female was 80

The number of convicted and unconvicted inmates as well as their gender analysis on monthly basis was detailed in table 3.5.

39 females were convicted and to unconvicted in the year. A total of 5837 inmates were either convicted or unconvicted in Ekiti in 2020, where 97 of the total were females. Further details was given in fig.14. The record of

arrival into the Federal correctional services Ado-Ekiti on account of their sex and the month was given in Table 3.6. it was noted that inmates with earlier convictions either once or twice were just 84.

Table 3.7 gives the distribution of inmates in Federal correctional services , Ado-Ekiti by the type of offence in 2019. Under different offences listed in the year are stealing, rape, forgery, murder and assault among many. The offence relating to armed robbery took the highest percentage of 22.3, followed by murder which accounts for 20%, stealing gulped 17.3% while 5 people or 0.9% were nabbed for forgery. The percentage of female found guilty of offences relating to murder and obtain under presence were 5 which accounts for 0.9% of the total 539.

The Statistics of convicts leaving Federal correctional services by sex and length of sentence in Ekiti State for 2019 was given 123 as total comprising of 3 females or 2.4% of the total while others were male

As high as 86 inmates or 69.9% were the number of inmates that had sentence of 2 years but less than 10 years.

Monthly record of convicts leaving Federal Correctional Services Ado-Ekiti by their age and sex was the focus of table 3.9 which shows that 88 inmates comprising of 87males and 1 female that falls to the middle age or working class of the population were in the correctional center. Only 8 young men of fewer than 20 years were also there while 4 men of over 50 years were also recorded.

The highest number of 4 convicts departed from the Federal correctional services Ado-Ekiti in the month of March. Details of available training opportunity to empower the inmates at the Federal correctional services, Ado-

Ekiti were captured in table 3.10, which shows a total of 95 inmates that assessed the opportunity. The skills included, Recreation/sport, tailoring and barbing. Technical vocation, .A total of 10 male inmates underwent barbing while 5 went for Tailoring.

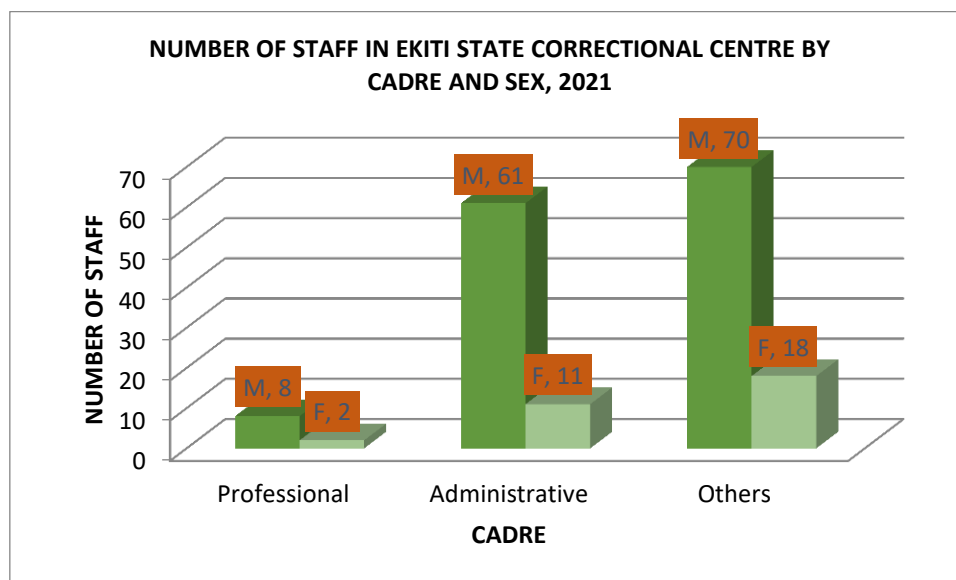

SECTION FOUR

There were a total of 93 courts spread across all the LGAs of Ekiti State in 2019. Available Statistics shows that there was no Local Government in Ekiti without at least two (2) types of courts. Specifically, the type of courts in Ekiti State adequately represents the 3 level of powers while there were 3 Federal High Courts in the State located only in Ado Local Government, other Local Government Areas excluding Ekiti West, Gbonyin, Ilejemeje, Irepodun/Ifelodun Moba, and oye did not have State high courts in their domains. As regards customary courts, Local Government Areas like Ido/Osi, Ijero and Irepodun/Ifelodun has 4 customary courts each.

Out of the 33 magistrate courts spread across the 16 LGAs of Ekiti State, Ekiti South-West, Ekiti West, Ijero, Ikere and Irepodun/ Ifelodun has 4 each. Aside Ado-Ekiti which is the State capital with the highest number of courts being 19 or 20.4%, Ijero has 8 (8.6%), Ekiti south west, Ido/Osi and Irepodun/Ifelodun has 7 (7.5%) courts each.

The record of rank of judges by their sex was detailed in table 4.2 there were 11 judges, 32 magistrates and 17 customary court presidents in 2019. Available information reveals the sex of the judges in Ekiti to give a total of 60 judges out of which 28 or 4.7% were females. There was only 1 female judge and 12 female customary presidents. See fig15 for further details.

Table 4.3 focuses on the classes of Ekiti Indigenes who were Senior Advocates of Nigeria (SAN) by sex in 2018. The 8 recorded SANS who were indigenes were in private practices.

Reported cases by type of offence and the sex of the accused persons in Ekiti State in year 2019 show that there were 392 alleged persons with 91 being females or 23.2% and 301 males or 77% as contained in table 4.4.

Record of disposition order of several court cases handled in Ekiti State reported that offences in relation to murder, suicide, Assaults, stealing and

manslaughter were investigated and tried. 112 person were involved in all, where 19 of the accused persons were females or 17%, 93 males (83%). see fig16 for further details.
