# EKITI STATE WATER AND SANITATION REGULATORY AGENCY (EK-WASRA)

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**IN EXERCISE** of the powers contained in Section 67 of the Ekiti State Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) Law, 2021, the Agency hereby makes the following Regulations:

The Regulation may be cited as Water Supply and Sanitation (Licensing of Utilities and Service Providers) Regulation, 2021.

- 1. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires-
  - "Agency" means the Ekiti State Water and Sanitation Regulatory Agency established under the Water Sector Law
  - "licensee" means a holder of a license issued under the Law.
- 2. (1) A Utility or service provider shall, on the publication of these Regulations, apply to the Agency for a licence to provide water supply or sanitation services in accordance with the form set out in the First Schedule to these Regulations. (2) An applicant for a licence shall submit the following documents with the
  - application form:(a) A business plan outline
    - i. The short, medium and long term objectives of the company for the provision of an efficient affordable and sustainable water supply and sanitation service;
    - ii. The strategic plan outlining the strengths and weaknesses of the company and the performance targets;
    - iii. The general company description as regards its organisation, management and shareholding;
    - iv. The plan of activities and programmes for a period of three years;
    - v. The efficiency improvement indicators;

- vi. The contracts and agreements that the company is party to;
- vii. The scope of improvement of water quality and customer service;
- viii. The type of water supply or sanitation facilities to be provided or used; and
  - ix. The tariff propositions and justifications for the propositions;
- (b) a copy of the company registration certificate;
- (c) the financial projections of the company outlining
  - (i) the profit and loss account
  - (ii) the balance sheet;
  - (iii) the cash flow statement;
  - (iv) the financial means to carry out the investment programme;
- (d) the investment outlining ----
  - (i) the supply and sales forecast stating the assumptions and objectives respecting the service area population coverage, service area population growth, the demand per capital consumption, production and distribution losses, the exploitable resources and infrastructure, capacity for water supply, storage and treatment capacity for waste water; and
  - (ii) investment expenditure projection stating the priorities for investment and the economic justification, the proportion of investment in extensions of existing systems, rehabilitation and renewal of existing systems equipment.
- **3.** (1) An applicant for a licence shall pay to the Agency an application fee as set out in the second Schedule.
  - (2) A licensee shall pay to the Agency a monthly licence fee as set out in the Second Schedule
- **4.** A licensee shall, not later than three months after the expiry of its financial year, submit to the Agency –

- (a) a financial report concerning its activities during its financial year; and
- (b) a technical report outlining the information set out in the Third Schedule.
- 5. (1) A licensee shall keep and maintain a record of its activities, inventory, financial and infrastructural improvements and all information required for purposes of these Regulations in accordance with the information management systems approved by the Agency.
  - (2) Where, in the opinion of the Agency, any information submitted to it, is not in accordance with the term of the Agency guidelines, does not comply with quality standards or is not submitted at the prescribed period, the Agency shall notify the licensee and stipulate the period not exceeding fourteen days, within which adequate and satisfactory information in compliance with the guideline should be submitted.
  - (3) where a licensee fails to comply with the requirements under regulation (2), the Agency may invoke the provisions of sections fourteen and twenty- one of the Law.
- **6.** The Agency shall establish guidelines for the setting of tariffs charged for the provision of water supply and sanitation services which
  - (a) contribute to an equitable distribution of water;
  - (b) allow for total cost recovery under the premise of efficient management by the provider and sufficient investment for infrastructure;
  - (c) bring the bill the customer has to pay in line with the customer's actual consumption and differentiate between consumer groups;
  - (d) Make the customer benefit from reductions in costs achieved through enhanced efficiency; and
  - (e) Do not pass expenses due to inefficiency on the part of providers on the customer.

- d) the mode, period and reason for restriction on water use by consumers;
- e) the total number of water supply interruptions both planned and unplanned;
- f) the total number of industries and commercial sites connected to a sewerage system;
- g) the number of government institutions serviced;
- h) the number properties flooded by foul water from the sewerage system;
- i) the water delivered and leakage;
- j) the total volume of water abstracted from surface or ground water to the system
- k) the total volume of water produced from treatment plants;
- 1) the total energy consumed in the company during operation in a day.
